

Notice From Noile about Impersonation Message

Thank you for your attentions and understanding for our business and initiatives.

We have confirmed that since around the end of July 2025, spoofed emails (spam) have been sent pretending to be from our employees or executives.

Specific examples include emails pretending to be from our company, using account imitate our company's email addresses who send requests for large, high-value orders in various e-commerce sites such non-related, or from bio-related companies, including CROs.

If you receive an email inquiry from us to seem suspicious, please contact us not to hesitate. In such cases, we would appreciate it if you could contact us using the inquiry form on our website.

Furthermore, as these types of spoofed emails may pose a risk of virus infection, redirection to phishing sites, and unauthorized access to your network, please take appropriate action such as not viewing attachments or carelessly clicking on URLs in the email text.

After analyzing the information, you have provided so far, we have determined that the purpose of this scam is to steal purchasing information from recipients and unfairly exploit them for products, so please be careful.

As mentioned above, when spoofing, the names of former employees or fictitious employees have been used, wherever all cases they can be distinguished by the sender address.

Furthermore, we have not confirmed any information leaks from our company, such as business partner information, and our company has no involvement in such spoofed emails.

In the future, we might believe that spoofed emails using different patterns may be sent, so please exercise even greater caution.
